## **Agenda Updates**

- Playground Project was discussed this is a past effort, proposals were solicited for updating the equipment in Joshua Park – this was led by Kate Ross since Q3 of 2016.
- Town states we will not be able to utilize or add to current surface
- Weather occurrences in April 2017 delayed the project

- No added update or timeline via Pat Pinkerton
- Discussion:
  - Consideration of Kessler Center population and usage of the equipment and what types of equipment needs would differ vs. general town need
  - Added comment: Kessler 20% through fundraising for their own on-campus playground project so town may not need to consider this
  - Joshua Rojas Foundation Kate to discuss their needs/goals and how this may contribute to park decisions
  - NOLA association (south of Rogers Orchard) has been contacted to see what type of feedback they may have in park construction

#### **Resident Ideas/Discussion**

- "Undesirable" End of Joshua Park / former bocce ball area
  - Potential to discuss addition of dog run in the former bocce ball area
  - Annual Permitting done by the municipality this could be a potential revenue source, such as Ellison Park handles, thus making the project attractive for Irondequoit
  - Minor discussion regarding posting rules, safety, etc as is posted in other similar parks.
- Welcome Packets
  - Helps Neighborhood when there is Real Estate Turnover
  - Discussion of having Small One-Pager such as Winona Woods, and other associations for realtors to have on hand for house showings, open houses etc
  - Ryan Arnold to create and take inspiration from already-existing resources
  - Solicit neighbor input on favorite places such as Food, Ice Cream, amenities
- Plant Swap
  - Looking at Irondequoit FB page there has been recent discussion of interest with multiple positive responses
  - Will report back, next quarter 3-4 members expressed interest and will discuss offline (Mary, Rich, Allison)
- Long Term Community Garden Project (at end caps of streets/ main intersections
  - o This is a popular project other associations take on
  - o Idea circulated of potential to have Kessler Center Student Involvement
  - Comments made on communicating idea and responsibilities in future discussions
  - "Start Small" and let it bloom from there
- September 17th Marathon
  - Will be discussed at the next meeting.
  - Let Kim Miranda know about interest between now and July
  - Neighborhoods will be sponsoring a theme on sections of St Paul Blvd
  - Athletes in race vote on their favorites cash awards will be given to winners, which could help with developing future projects
